

Acer platanoides is a fast-growing tree that will thrive in nutrient-poshade and is a good nurse tree.

Shape and habit

One of the first considerations is the shape of a tree, which must fit into the overall garden landscape (see Tree shapes, pages 286–93). Fastigiate, columnar and upright-growing trees, such as Tasus barata. Fastigiata, are excellent for hiding narrow objects, such as telephone or utility poles. Trees like Querus rebut fastigiate or Cupressus sumpervirus. Stricta Group can produce a tropical feel if they are planted with yuccas and palms.

Pendulous or weeping trees bring a graceful silhouette to a landscape. Round-headed trees bring massive green outlines and their trunks create interesting architectural patterns that change during the day as the sun gives way to shade.
